Discover Native Cultures

Over the course of our 11-day trip, we'll enjoy premium resorts and plenty of discretionary activities, along with the kind of carefully arranged, off-the-beaten-path scenic, agricultural and small-town stops our travelers appreciate. Another fun element of this redesigned tour is encountering the rich cultural traditions and lore of diverse indigenous Pacific islanders that traveled, settled and ruled these isles. We'll hear tales of the legendary goddess Pele, the islands' unification under King Kamehameha, the overthrow of Queen Liliuokalani, and more.

Meet the Monarchs

In Honolulu, we'll be introduced to Iolani Palace—the only royal palace on American soil—and see the majestic statue of King Kamehameha the Great. Then, we'll be dazzled by the spectacular **Magic of Polynesia** Dinner and Cocktail Show, where thrilling magic acts and effects combine with such performance styles as Hula, Tahitian and fireknife dancing.

A captivating trip to scenic Nuuanu Pali recalls the **Battle of Nuuanu**, among the bloodiest conflicts in Hawaiian history, where Kamehameha conquered Oahu in his quest to unite the Islands.

Paths of Chiefs

Later, meet an authentic **Polynesian Chief, Sielu**, who will share many customs of the native islanders on an educational trip through botanical gardens. We'll learn to open a coconut, make fire from sticks and coconut husk, and other fun skills! For Day 4's free time, you may opt to explore the expansive **Polynesian Cultural Center**, Hawaii's most-visited paid attraction.

A Big Island highlight is seeing the temples and ki'i (carved wooden images) of sacred **Puuhonua o Honaunau** National Historical Park, an ancient "Place of Refuge" where those sentenced to death could find protection under the power of buried chiefs.

Maui, More than Beaches

In the stunningly scenic **Iao Valley**, we'll relive the tale of Kamehameha's defeat of Maui's army in the 18th century, dramatically altering Hawaiian history. Atop breathtaking **Haleakala** ("House of the Sun"), learn how the demigod Maui lassoed the sun from the volcano's summit, slowing its descent to make the day last longer. And in a fitting ending to our Pacific adventure, our farewell banquet, "**Drums of the Pacific**," is a festive luau featuring traditional Polynesian music, dance, costume, crafts, food and celebration. You'll head home feeling like *Ohana*—part of Hawaii's family!
